After first learning of the Best Case Series Program in November 1996, from Dr. Wayne Jonas MD., the then Director of the NIH's (National Institutes of Health, USA) Office of Alternative Medicine (OAM), it took Dr. Prasanta Banerji and Dr. Pratip Banerji until March 1998 to submit their cases. After comprehensive scrutiny and many queries, the NCI accepted the series as complete in March 1999, and their presentation to the CAPCAM occurred in July 1999.
